Reasons to Service a Chainsaw

Like any tool, a chainsaw is the most effective and safest when it is serviced regularly. Just like the old adage says, "A dull knife is more dangerous than a sharp one," your chainsaw can pose a serious safety risk if the teeth of the chain are dull or broken. A professional technician can determine how much is left on the cutting teeth and how to sharpen the depth gauges between the teeth.

If you are using your chainsaw regularly, the teeth will wear down faster. Once the cutting teeth are below 4mm, it is time to replace the chain. But replacing the chain is only half of the battle. Proper tension of the chain is also necessary both for safety and effectiveness. Too loose and the chain can slip. Too tight and it can bend the bar.

bar, brake, air filter, clutch and flywheel inspected and replaced as needed by your service technician. These parts aid in high performance and safety as well. Check the lubrication every time you use your chainsaw. An under-lubricated chain can cause serious functional issues and may even pose a severe safety hazard. A quick visual inspection should be done

Portable Generators – Safe Use

Read the operational and user guides for the generator before starting or using it.

Do not remove warning stickers or any safety device

Use only outdoors and away from vents, windows and doors. Generators put out a lot of fumes and can endanger lives if the fumes are breathed in for too long.

Listen to the generator and familiarize yourself with the sound. Changes in the normal sounds can mean problems.

Create proper ventilation on all sides of the generator

Properly ground the generator to prevent electric shock

Keep the generator in a clean, dry location. Shelter it from rain and snow without sacrificing ventilation.

Do not touch or start the generator with wet hands.

Use properly rated extension cords. If the cord is damaged or hot to the touch, replace it immediately.

Turn off the main circuit breaker of the house or building before turning on the generator.

Overloading a generator is dangerous. Only load up to 80% of the generator’s running watts.

Never connect a generator to an existing wiring system unless a DPDT electric transfer switch is in place to prevent back feed.

Separate generator power from external lines.

Fuel should always be stored in approved ANSI-compliant containers for safety.

Never have an open flame or lit tobacco product near a generator while it is being fueled or operating

Power down the generator to add fuel. If possible, allow the generator to cool before adding the fuel.

Service the generator twice a year even if it has not been used. This will ensure that the generator is in good working order and safe to use.

Power up your generator at least once a month to make sure it will start. If the power goes out and your generator will not start, chances are that your service representative will be without power also and unable to fix it.
