## Telescopic Pruners - Uses and Benefits

A Telescopic Pruner is a valuable tool to both professional gardeners and home gardeners. Telescopic pruners can be a welcomed addition to the tool set of any gardener who needs the capacity of reach when pruning. For those who are not familiar with telescopic pruners, I would like to explain the basic uses and benefits.

### Tree, Hedge and Plant Maintenance and Health

Telescopic pole pruners allow a gardener to reach into large or thick hedges and trees to remove stems or branches and to trim back overgrowth. Telescopic pole pruners are also great when maintaining thorny bushes or hedges, so you can avoid injuries.

Also, the health of a tree or hedge can be improved through pruning. Some diseases can spread more quickly if affected branches are not removed. Also, pruning dense trees allows better sunlight to other parts of the tree and even allows for better air circulation.

Shaping trees and removing damaged branches or branches that are rubbing together and bruising is also achieved through pruning. Telescopic pole pruners allow the gardener to shape trees much more easily since many can allow the user to reach 15 feet or more.

### Working Safely and Removing the Chances of Property Damage

Telescopic pole Pruners allows the user to work from the ground, eliminating the use of ladders and the possibility of falling.

Telescopic pole pruners also allow users to reach across pools or ponds and decrease the chances of falling in. Pole pruners can also allow users to avoid carrying heavy and dangerous saws or chainsaws up into trees which can be very dangerous.

When branches are diseased or damaged, they become a safety hazard to people and property. Telescopic pruners can be used to remove these branches. Also, when trees grow too close to power lines or phone lines, severe storms or heavy snows may cause branches to damage or bring down these lines. Pruning trees is very important in these situations. A VERY IMPORTANT NOTE: Be very careful when pruning around power lines. Many times, it is better to have a professional tree cutting service or arborist perform the necessary work.

### Safely Harvesting Flowers or Fruit

If you have fruit trees, flowering shrubs or bushes, telescopic pruners can be a great tool to remove what you are harvesting with safety to you and the fruit or flower you are removing. Picking ripe apples or oranges from the ground is a lot easier and safer than getting up into the tree with a ladder. Some telescopic pruners also have a cut-and-grab feature that holds the fruit or flower after you have cut it. This allows you to

carry the fruit or flower safely to the ground without damaging or bruising it by dropping it.

Also, as mentioned earlier, using a telescopic pruner to remove flowers from a rose bush or other thorny bush keeps your hands and arms safe from painful scratches. And, if you've ever climbed into a tree thick with branches, you also know you can be scratched or poked with sharp branches, which is both painful and dangerous.

Pruning is an important part of keeping your plants, hedges and trees healthy and beautiful, and telescopic pruners are a great tool to make pruning faster, easier, and much safer. And telescopic pruners can be a great gift for the person who has just about every other garden tool.
